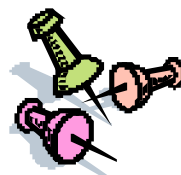
Wine Tasting Event Coming in May

Dave graduated from Media High School, Temple University, and the Temple University Law School, practicing since 1958. He served in the Navy 4 years on active duty, and then in the Naval Reserve, retiring as a Lieutenant Commander.

A resident of Lansdowne since 1954, Dave was on the Lansdowne Zoning Board 1964 – 1968 and was Solicitor to the Zoning Board from 1992 through 1994. In recent years, he has concentrated in real estate, business, estate and financial planning and administration, and elder law.

Long Active in Civic and Professional Matters

Dave, a resident of Lansdowne since 1954, was president of many local organizations, such as Rotary Club of Darby-Lansdowne, Delaware County Community Nursing Service, Delaware County Estate Planning Council, Lansdowne Allied Youth Council, Lansdowne Union Athletic Association, and the Lansdowne Neighbors Club.

He also provided legal services for other local organizations, including Lansdowne Cultural Alliance, Greater Lansdowne Civic Association, and Darby Little League.

Hennessy is an original member of the LBPA, and was president from 1979 – 80. He served on the Fun Sunday committee and was General Chairman for one year. The event raised several thousand dollars each year; some of which was used for the planning and development of the mini-park, across from the Lansdowne Theater.

In 1991, Dave originated the Lansdowne Arts and Crafts Fair as a joint venture of the Rotary Club and the Lansdowne Cultural Alliance. This annual event funded Lansdowne’s Centennial Celebration in 1993.

Joe Bullen’s civic contributions include 5 years on the Marple-Newtown School Board, chairman of the Delco Youth Services Commission, chairman of the Drug and Alcohol Commission, and as a member of Rotary International for over 25 years; he is current president of the Newtown Square Rotary Club.

Joseph W. Bullen III

Bullen graduated from Lansdowne-Aldan High School, then Dickinson College, and Temple University Law School. His counseling and trial work includes extensive business, estate, domestic relations, and motor vehicle matters, including DUI.

Before practicing law, Joe was a Trust Officer with Bryn Mawr Trust Company. He counts more than 30 years as a lawyer in civil and criminal trial, as well as appellate practice.

Joe served on active duty in the Army and then in the Army Reserve, where his Unit deployed soldiers to Iraq, Bosnia, Haiti, and Panama. He retired as a Colonel in the Judge Advocate General Corps.

He is a faculty member at Delaware County Community College in its paralegal program, where he teaches contract law, criminal law, and elder law.
